## 1. Principal/Director: One

Preference for these appointments will be given to the Heads of the Department.

2. Three years teaching experience in the subject in a recognized Medical college as Resident / Demonstrator/ Tutor.

##### Demonstrator / Tutor:

1. MBBS degree from a recognized institution. Non – medical persons having M.Sc in Medical Anatomy, Medical Physiology & Medical Biochemistry may also apply.

Appointments will be given initially for a period of 1 year which may be extendable upto 3 years.

Appointments will be given initially for a period of 6 months which may be extendable upto 1 year.

In addition to the above the rates of Non Practicing pay for the medical teachers would be as follows:

A) For Demonstrator/Tutor/ Assistant Professor- 25% of ( Basic Pay& Grade pay)+Rs 8,000 per month.

B) For Associate Professor/Professor-25% of ( Basic Pay& Grade pay)+Rs 10,000 per month.

C) For Medical Superintendent/Principal-25% of ( Basic Pay& Grade pay)+Rs 12,000 per month.

Applicants presently working in Central/State Govt. will be offered pay protection as per rule.

**General Conditions:**

1. Complete application in all respects and signed by the candidate should reach to the **Registrar, The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, DD-36, Sector 1, Salt lake city, Kolkata-64 within 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009.**
2. The envelope should be super-scribed with the post and discipline applied for.
3. Separate applications should be sent, if the candidate is applying for more than one post.
4. Self attested photocopies of the certificates of educational & testimonials showing experience etc. should be attached with the application.
5. Incomplete applications will be rejected without any intimation to the candidate.
6. Employees of Government or semi Government should apply through proper channel. They may send an advance copy in time.
7. No objection certificate should be submitted from the Employer during interview.
8. No TA/DA is permissible if called for interview.
9. Mere submission of application does not confer any right to the candidate for being called for interview.
10. The posts is/are full time & private practice of any kind is prohibited.
11. Reservation of posts as per rule of Government of West Bengal.
